COMMITTEE CHARGE

The Academy of Emerging Professionals Council of Advisors (AEP COA) is a steering committee comprised of elected leaders representing various constituencies. They establish connections among and advocates on behalf of architecture school students, aspiring and recently licensed architects, as well as the individuals that mentor these important groups of people.

OVERARCHING GOALS/OUTCOMES FOR 2023

1. Support pipeline efforts by continuing to bridge the gap between AIAS and AIA CA.
2. Administer statewide licensure recognition program for newly licensed architects.
3. Host annual AEP Summit, bringing together EP leaders from every component to discussion issues impacting young professionals.
4. Develop improved communication with local chapter CACE members and Emerging Professional leaders and members for better support, resource development, and recognition of noteworthy individuals and programs.
5. Create communication opportunities that align with the AEP mission in social media, our digital publication *arcCA Digest*, the AIACA website, and outward communication efforts by AIACA.

STATUS SUMMARY / RECOMMENDATIONS

The AEP has presented its Declaration to the BOD in an informational meeting and are collecting feedback before the vote at the June 16th board of Directors meeting. The Statewide ARE Study Program is expected to begin this year, with more updates in a few months. AEP Student Directors are focusing on closing the gap between students and AIA, creating a closer connection between AIAS and AEP COA.
