Background and Description: The University of California, Santa Barbara ("UCSB") is located on a mesa overlooking the Pacific Ocean, the UCSB campus offers a unique academic setting removed from urban pressures yet brimming with cultural and academic vitality. UCSB enrolls approximately 25,000 students, including recent year classes that are the most academically competitive and ethnically diverse in campus history. The project is intended to increase the functionality of the Student Resource Building's two outdoor decks with a permanent shade structure. The projected construction budget is \$662,000.
